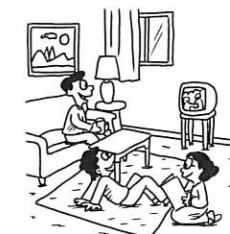

Here, he earned a loyal following and developed a technique of hanging around hotel lobbies, using overheard conversations to base his writing on. Disaster soon struck as he was sentenced to five years in prison for stealing money from the place he worked. However, jail time may have been a blessing in disguise, as he adopted his pen name and wrote 14 stories while he was in prison.
